There is immediate confirmation of online entries only!

Entry Fees: Every swimmer pays a base fee of **\$60** to come to the meet.
Individual event swimmers must add **\$6** for each individual event entered.
If you are only swimming relays you must pay the base fee of **\$60**.

Relay Fees: Relays are **\$15 / event / relay team**.

Meet Registration:

The Registration Desk is upstairs in the Olympic lounge at the pool. Meet packages must be picked up in person or by a team representative. Swimmers must register before they can swim.

Registration desk hours are:

Friday	1 pm to end of events
Saturday and Sunday:	7 am to end of events
Monday	7 am to end of events

Swimmers with a Disability (SWAD)

We encourage swimmers with a disability who are registered as Masters swimmers to participate.

Rules:

MSC Rules (2008) and Warm-up Procedures will govern the meet.

Eligibility:

The Championships is open to registered Masters swimmers at least 18 years old as of May 15, 2009. Age as of December 31, 2009 will determine age groups. Canadian entrants shall indicate registration number and club affiliation or their status as an unattached swimmer on the entry form. International swimmers must submit proof of affiliation with their National, FINA affiliated, Masters organization. Please email a digital photo of proof to cmssc2009@aol.com.

Medals, Ribbons, Patches and Engraving:

Swimmers finishing in the top three, **including relays**, will receive medals. Swimmers finishing 4th to 8th including relays, will receive ribbons. Swimmers finishing first in an individual event will receive a Canadian Champion patch; one per swimmer. **All awards must be picked up at the meet**, upstairs in the Olympic Lounge. Engraving will be available on site.

Seeding:

All events shall be swum slowest to fastest. All events of 100 m or less and 4 x 50m relays will be swum by age and gender. 200m events and 4 x 100m relays will be seeded either by gender or by age and gender at the discretion of meet management depending on number of entrants. Events 400m and over will be swum by gender only; slowest to fastest. 800m and 1500m freestyle may be swum 2 per lane at the discretion of Meet Management. Bring your own lap counter.

Age Groups: 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, and there after in increments of 5 years.

Relays:

Entries must be done online at www.cmssc2009.ca. (Payment is by Visa, MC) Immediate confirmation of entries will be provided. Relays will be grouped by cumulative swimmer age using the following increments; 72-99, 100-119, 120-159, and thereafter in increments of 40 years. A mixed relay team consists of 2 men and 2 women.

No swimmer may swim more than once in any relay event.

Each club must indicate the number of relay teams entered in each event. The names, ages and order of team members for each team must be submitted to the relay clerk of course first thing Sunday morning as per later instructions.

As noted above, relay teams finishing in the top 3 will receive Medals but these must be picked up at the meet.

Results:

Electronic copies of results will be posted at the meet website. There will be NO published results booklet.
